If all obligations of the Village related to such park improvements have been paid in full prior to the expiration of such period, the Village Board will terminate the sales and use tax rate effective as of the first day of the calendar quarter immediately following the action of the Village Board. If the sales and use tax rate increase is not approved, the proposed park improvements and betterments will not be completed or will be completed using alternative funding sources which have not yet been determined.</p>

Additional Information Regarding Proposed Local Sales and Use Tax Rate Increase:

Revenues from the increased sales and use tax are designated to be used to fund park improvements and betterments, and to pay debt service on bonds of the Village issued to pay the cost of such park improvements and betterments. If all obligations of the Village related to such park improvements have been paid in full prior to the expiration of such period, the Village Board will terminate the sales and use tax rate effective as of the first day of the calendar quarter immediately following the action of the Village Board. If the sales and use tax rate increase is not approved, the proposed park improvements and betterments will not be completed or will be completed using alternative funding sources which have not yet been determined.

If all obligations of the Village related to such park improvements have been paid in full prior to the expiration of such period, the Village Board will terminate the sales and use tax rate effective as of the first day of the calendar quarter immediately following the action of the Village Board. If the sales and use tax rate increase is not approved, the proposed park improvements and betterments will not be completed or will be completed using alternative funding sources which have not yet been determined.
